- COURSE** Course distance is approximately three miles. The course traverses various surfaces to include dirt roads, fields, ponds and mud trails. Numerous obstacles are incorporated into the course. Highlights include walls, trenches and mud pits!!
- RACE** Individual runners or teams consisting of four runners will start the race. The **first individual runner** and the **first four-member team** to cross the finish line together will decide the order of finish.
- ATTIRE** Difficulty of the course and rough-n-ready attire is an integral part of the event. While safety precautions have been taken, the nature of this event recommends that runners wear attire that reduces the possibility of mishap (i.e., *long pants, boots, long sleeve shirt, gloves*).

REGISTRATION Registrations postmarked **on/before August 11, 2011**: \$30 each runner / \$120 per team.
Registrations postmarked **after August 11, 2011**: \$45 each runner / \$180 per team.
